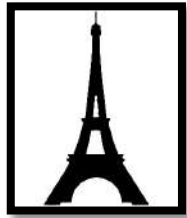

ALIGNMENT

- Power generation EPS $250\text{gCO}_2/\text{kWh}_e$
- Gas fired power plants when meeting EPS over economic life and blend low-carbon gas
- Waste-to-energy meets EPS and applies waste hierarchy
- DH network meets efficiency criteria of the EE Directive or there is a viable decarbonisation plan and the project does not increase GHG emissions on annual basis



PARIS

ALIGNMENT

- Mobile assets for transport services: 50 g CO₂/ passenger km
- Road rehabilitation, road safety, regional roads (up to 25M EUR)
- Strategic roads if meet economic test, consistent with planning and alternative fuel infrastructure
- Rail and other public transport infrastructure
- Port infrastructure
- Improving existing airport capacity but no new capacity
